

## CLL Live 2018 Evaluation Summary

### Respondent profile:

In total, 121 completed the evaluation. Of the respondents 103 were Canadian, 15 were American and there was 3 unidentified. Of the 121, 39 were watch and wait, 15 had one treatment, 28 had multiple treatments, 31 were companions and 8 did not identify their status.

### Selected comments from the 'things I like best' question

- Renewing my hope
- My wife and I am not alone in the CLL battle. We met wonderful people with great stories of living with CLL.
- How much we learned and that it was in a way that we could understand.
- Wait and Watch is not so bad after all :)
- I learned there is a lot of hope and found a lot of inspiration.

### Selected comments from the 'things I like least' question

- Being from the USA it seemed that the majority of the discussions were about the Canadian med system
- Long day, more breaks, stretching between talks
- Room was cold
- Some material too scientific

### Conference Location

- Niagara Falls: 103 like Niagara Falls location, 6 didn't like it.
- Toronto Area: 61 prefer the conference not held in the Toronto area. 32 prefer Toronto area.

### Rating of the sessions:

- The highest rated speaker had an 88% excellent rating. The lowest rated speaker had a 50% excellent rating.
- Breakout sessions: ranged between 65% excellent and 50% excellent.
- Panels: 82% excellent.

- 38 Excellent, 22 Above average, 9 Average, 43 did not attend

### Hotel: Value for Cost

- 39 Excellent, 24 Above average, 20 Average, 22 did not stay in the hotel

- Of the 121 respondents to the evaluation, 7 participated in the 2007 conference, 20 in 2009, 32 in 2012, 51 in 2015.
